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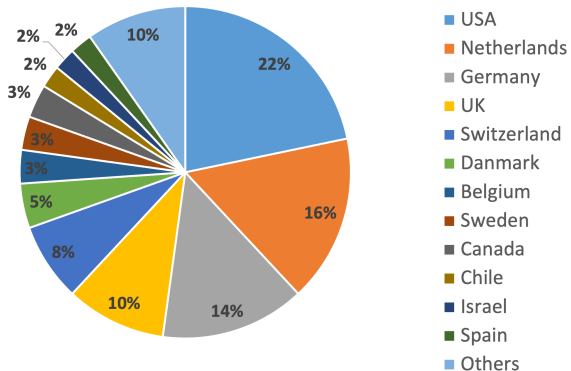

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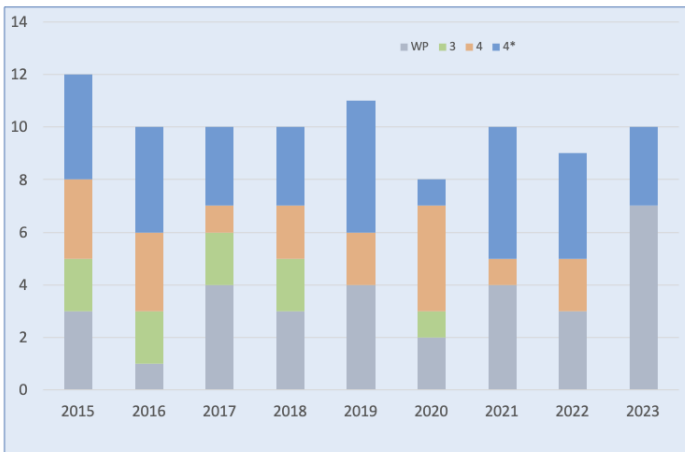


# Financial stability may not make headlines in the FT these days

But it remains key also in transformative times it seems: long-term average of 35% in RFS, JfE, JoF, etc.

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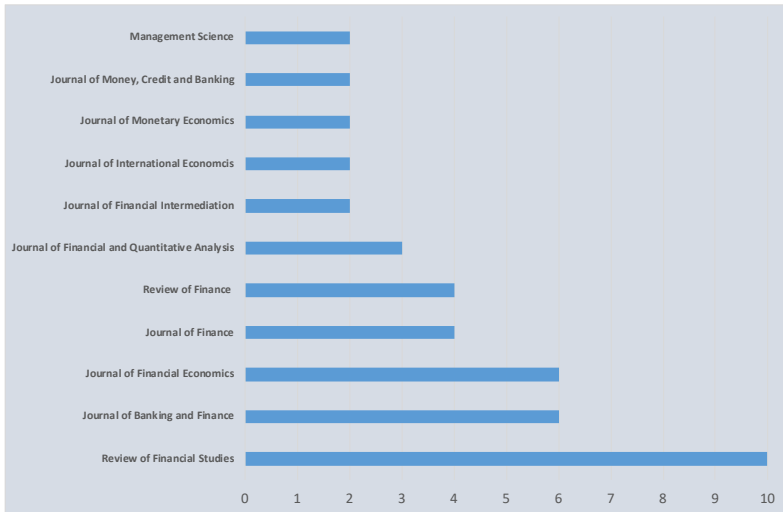


# Many academic outlets appear to share our taste
